About FGS

The Farmington Genealogical Society was founded in 1973 as a non-profit organization. It is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of officers serving two year terms and it functions through the volunteer efforts of its members. The society explores various methods of tracing ancestors and promotes education both for beginners and more experienced genealogists through speakers and workshops.

The society is a member of the Federation of Genealogical Societies, a non-profit organization comprised of more than 500 genealogical societies and libraries, representing more than over 200,000 individual genealogists. In addition, the society is affiliated with the Michigan Genealogical Council, a non-profit organization founded in 1972, with over 75 member societies in Michigan, representing thousands of genealogists.

In addition to offering instruction to assist the family historian, the goals of the society are to promote the gathering and exchange of methods and techniques for pursuing family history and preserving public records of interest to genealogists. Any person who is interested in pursuing family history is welcome to join the society or attend meetings as a visitor. The meetings are open to the public and are free of charge. Members are encouraged to participate in the many activities sponsored by the society.
