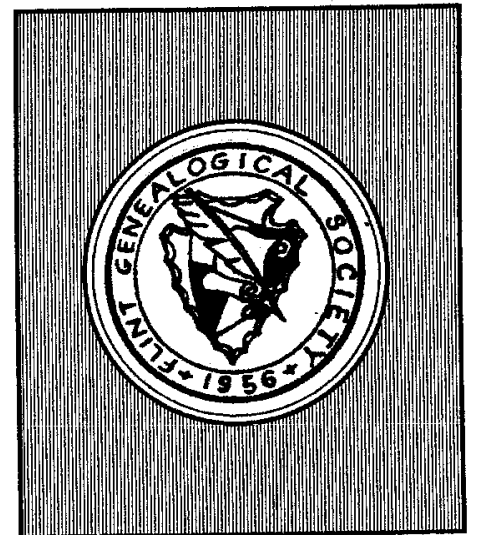

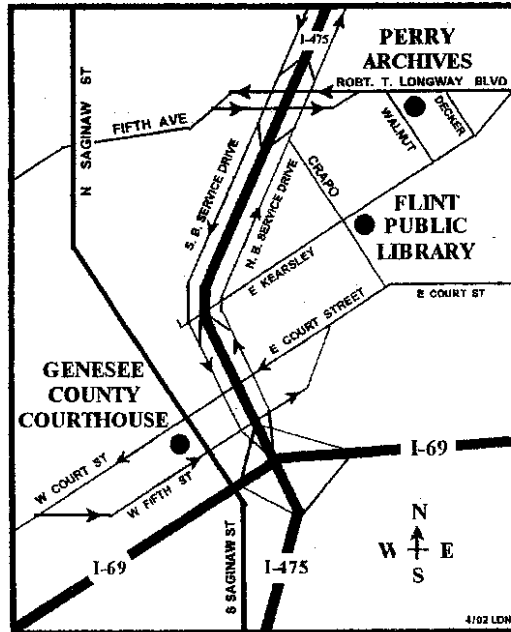

Becoming A Member

Persons interested in Genealogy and History, whether amateur or professional, are welcome to apply for membership in the Flint Genealogical Society.

Your membership includes a subscription to the *Flint Genealogical Quarterly* a special three issue publication. New members are entitled to back issues for the current year. Those who join in October, will be considered members through the following year. Our quarterly publication starts in January. Back issues are available at additional cost. As a new member you will receive two free ancestral charts. When filled in, they are

officially recorded in the society's permanent historical record book.

Members are encouraged to submit historical information and genealogical materials of interest to the Quarterly Editor for official publication, preferably original documentation, and/or records of research.

All queries to the *Flint Genealogical Quarterly* are free. However, we request you limit them to 50 words or less and include: Name, Date, and Place, whenever possible.

Genealogical Sources

Flint Public Library

Located at 1026 E. Kearsley Street (at Crapo), Flint MI 48502. The genealogical and local history resources are found in the General Reference Department. Our own Society volunteers assist the Library staff in serving visitors during select hours:

Genesee County Clerk's Office

Located at 1101 Beach St., Flint, MI 48502. Copies of certified and non-certified vital and historical records are available. The office personnel generally refer all genealogical research to the Flint Genealogical Society. The Society provides volunteers to assist seekers on Fridays from 9 am - 3:30 pm. Marriage records from 1836, and Birth & Death records from 1867 are available, with 100 year restrictions on the issuance of birth certificates. Research inquiries are welcome. Call: (810) 257-3225

Perry Archives - The Sloan Museum

Located at 1221 E. Kearsley St., Flint MI 48503. Call (810) 237-3439. Open Wednesday 9 am - 3 pm (they break for lunch from 11 am to about 12:00 pm). Historical Archives and many other genealogy resources are found here.
