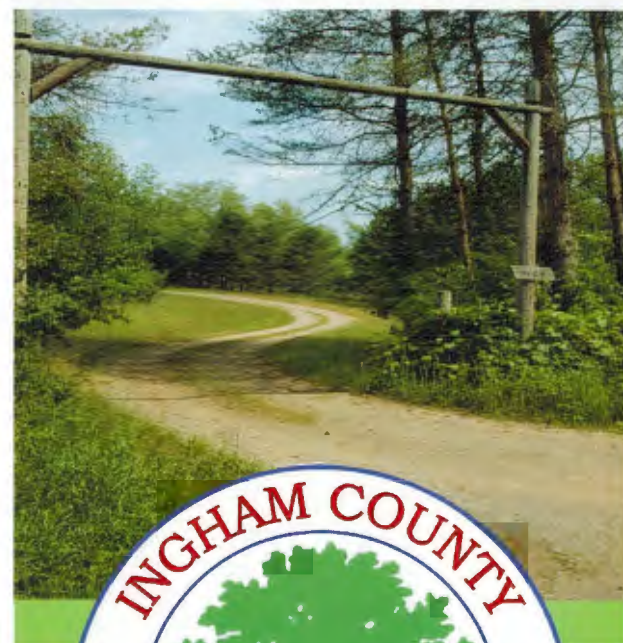

Facility is not handicap accessible. However, the librarian will meet with patrons on the first level.



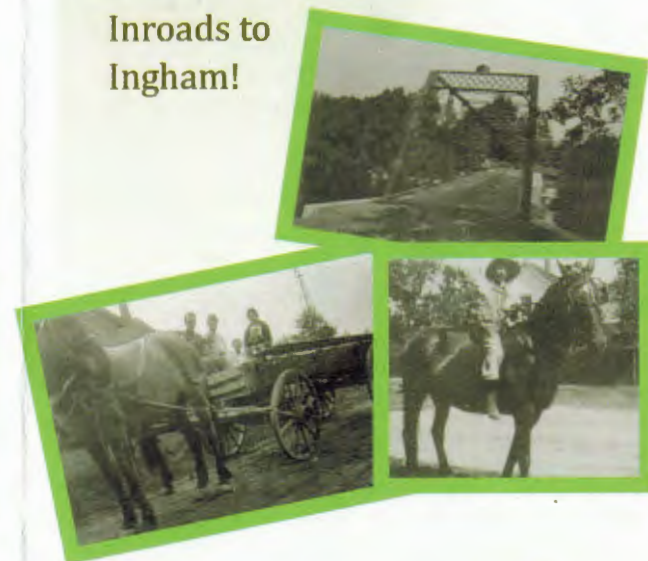
