PGSM History

The PGSM was established in June, 1978 at a meeting held at the Albert J. Zak Library in Hamtramck, Michigan. The first major workshop was held at the Bloomfield Family History Center in November, 1978, and sponsored by the Church of Jesus Christ Latter-day Saints.

In May, 1981, PGSM published its first newsletter, twelve pages in length. In 1982 the newsletter became *The Eaglet*, an expanded journal. The name was changed to *Polish Eaglet* in January, 1996 and now is a minimum of 44 pages.

PGSM is a tax exempt 501(c)(3) society and operates under a Constitution & Bylaws. The term in office for elected officers and directors is two years with elections held in odd numbered years.

Polish Eaglet

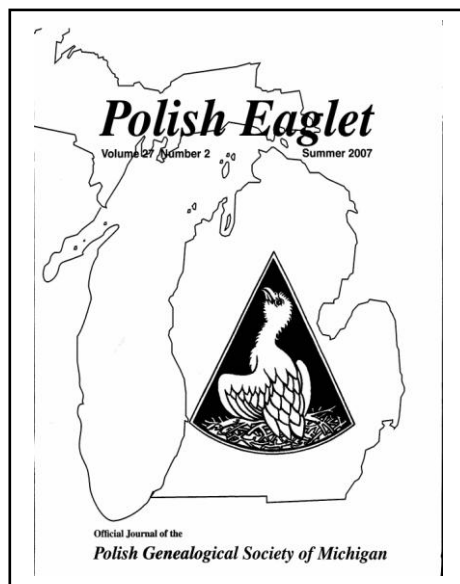
The *Polish Eaglet* is the official journal of the PGSM. It is published three times per year, and is a benefit of membership, and sent to all members and selected libraries.
